CHASSIS FEE SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Overview

You can charge your customer chassis fee based on the number of days between the pick up and the return date which we name it as chassis usage day.

The most simple way to charge your customer is the number of days x the chassis fee rate, for example 6/1 picked up and 6/10 returned, then the chassis fee will be 10 days x the chassis rate.

The chassis fee rate can be set up in Charge Code under "Operation Master Tables" and the invoice template in the customer profile.

Set up different ways to charge the chassis fee

You can also set up the chassis fee in the following ways.

1/ The Minimum


You can charge your customer a fixed amount if the chassis usage day is less than what you specified, otherwise regular/specific rate will apply instead.

For example you can set up something like this:

Charge your customer \$500 if the usage day is less than or equal to 3 days, otherwise charge \$100 per day. In this way, a customer will be charged \$500 if the chassis usage day is 3 or less than 3 days, or if the chassis usage day is 10, then the fee will be calculated as 10 days x \$100 instead.

Follow the steps below to set this up

1.1 Select "Charge Code (General)" under "Operation Master Tables"



1.2 Choose/Edit "CHASSIS FEE" from the list




1.3 Select "YES" for "Apply Minimum"

Input the appropriate amount in "Minimum Charge" field (example, \$500)

Then, input the number of days for the minimum charge (example, 10)

Click "Save" button to save the record.



1.4 Once you have set up the general settings for the chassis fee, you can set up invoice template for a particular customer. Please refer to the instruction document: Billing-InvoiceTemplateforCustomer.pdf for details

2/ The Initial Charging

You can also set up the FREE period or specific rate within the initial usage days then apply the regular/specific rate to your customer after that.


For example you can set up something like this:

First 3 chassis usage days are free then \$11 per day after.


In this way, for 10 chassis usage days, the fee will be calculated as 7 days x \$11 (first 3 days are FREE).

Follow the steps below to set this up


2.1 Select "Charge Code (General)" under "Operation Master Tables"



2.2 Choose/Edit "CHASSIS FEE" from the list



2.3 Select "YES" for "Apply Initial Charging"
Input the number of days for the FREE period or initial rate.
If it is for FREE period, then input ZERO in "Initial Rate".
