

Overweight Shipment Warning Setup

This document is written to describe how to set up the system to display a warning message on the shipment details page when weight is over threshold.

Overview


System can be set up to display a warning message on the top of the shipment details page if the weight values input is over the threshold you set.

A/ Overweight threshold

Select "System Settings" under "System" menu.



Click the "OWGT" record, then Input the values in pound (LBS), click "Save" button
System will display warning message if the shipment weight is greater or equal to the values you input here.
